Mr. McGown was asked to write to Dr. F. T. Giles with the view of obtaining his estimate of the capital costs and operating costs per student for the type of academic and technological course programs we anticipate presenting. Dr. Giles will also be requested to give his opinion regarding a type of metro control plan for, possibly, four regional colleges in the Lower Mainland area. This administrative authority would plan the colleges and progress them so as to avoid needless duplication of facilities and attempt to present a coordinated program of courses throughout the four regional colleges.

Discussion ensued on the interpretation of the Minister's suggestions on March 9th, 1967. It was decided that Mr. Jones write a letter to the Minister of Education thanking him for his interview and outlining our understanding of the Minister's intentions regarding the next steps to be taken so that our request for a regional college may be progressed.

It was decided that a meeting be arranged for either April 5th or 6th, whichever date is more convenient to Dr. Chapman, and that other regional college committees in the Lower Mainland area be invited to attend. Mr. McGown was asked to find a suitable place and give notice of the meeting as soon as possible.
