- 6. The Committee agreed to recommend to the member Boards that they share jointly the costs of allowing Mr. Brooks to attend the Superintendent's Conference in Banff in April and the Junior College Leadership Programme in July. Total cost is estimated to be \$750.00.
- 7. Date of the next meeting was tentatively set for 12:00 noon, Tuesday, March 1st at the same place.
