REPORT ON MEETING WITH MR. W.E. LUCAS, MR. LES ENCOKS AND TRUSTLE PETER JONES HELD AT THE SYLVIA HOTEL ON THURSDAY, OCTOBER 14, 1965 AT 12:15 P.M.

The meeting was called for the purpose of discussing the implications and implementation of suggestions to Boards following the last joint meeting of Boards on the North Shore Junior College.

In discussions between Mr. Les Brooks and the authors of the Interim Report, it became apparent that the innister and Senior Department officials should be advised immediately of the steps already taken by Boards on the North Shore respecting the establishment of a Junior College. This was considered imperative and necessary in order to prevent first knowledge of our activities being conveyed to the Minister and senior officials by the press. Without proper preparation for an approach by the press, the reception of the idea of a Junior College on the North Shore could well be put in jeopardy.

It was therefore agreed that a letter be written to both limister and Senior Officials informing them of progress made to date and submitting for their perusal copies of the Interim Report.

In the meantime the Interim Report was to be put in its final form and a precis prepared for general distribution.

It was suggested that Boards at their first meeting pass the following two resolutions which were recommended by the joint meeting:

- (1) That the Board of School Trustees of West Vancouver receive the Interim Report of the North Shore Reginal College Study,
- (2) That this Board recommend that the North Shore Reginal College Study in its final form be reproduced in two forms; a complete form for internal use by the Board and a precis for distribution to the public, and that the format, selection of a printer and so on be left to a committee to be appointed by the joint action of the chairman of the commissioning boards (North Vancouver, S.D., 44 and Nest Vancouver, SD., 45), and costs to be borne in the same ratio as the cost of the study.

It was suggested that Boards refrain from further resolutions until the final report and precis are received. Pending this a joint meeting of both Boards would seem to be desirable in order to work out the mechanics of releasing the report and establishing a suitable publicity campaign.
