## **3,500 STUDENTS SIGN UP**

# Higher interest remains strong at Capilano College

INTEREST IN higher education continues to be strong on the North Shore.

Preliminary registration figures show that Capilano College continues to have an enrollment of more than 3,500 students.

College registrar David Wooley says there are about

1,750 full-time students and 1,800 part-time students registered for the latest terms at the college.

"Basically we're about where we were at this time last year," Wooley says.

Capilano College did not face the flood of students some lower mainland colleges faced, he adds, because the local institute went through that last year.

"In that respect we were

about a year ahead," says Wooley.

The effect of that is a crowded campus.

"We're almost filled to capacity," he says. "There may be the odd spot in individual classes still open, but the majority of classes are full."
