
The MEDIA RESOURCES PROGRAM

is a two-year, full-time career program open to persons over 18 years of age or with secondary school graduation.

Applicants must attend an Information Evening (dates given on back page), complete a written application and be interviewed by Media Resources faculty.

The class size is limited to 28 students and total applications usually number approximately 150. Although new classes do not begin until September, early involvement in the admission process is recommended.

In 15 years of operation, nearly 80% of Media Resources graduated have become employed in a media-related position within six months of graduation. Our graduates are currently working throughout the province in a wide variety of positions ---- A/V Co-ordinator, A/V Technician, A/V Producer, editor, production assistant, etc. ---- for a variety of educational institutions, commercial production companies, health care facilities and other organizations.


