
## Capilano College

Congratulations Capilano College graduates!

This information pamphlet has been prepared to help you to enjoy the graduation ceremonies at Capilano College. It contains details of departmental grad ceremonies (time and location), the central graduation ceremony, plus a map of the campus indicating location of ceremonies and available parking. If you require additional pamphlets for guests unfamiliar with the campus, they will be available in departmental offices, at the Student Society office, and at the main reception desk in Registration. Guides will be on campus to greet you and your guests and to provide any necessary information and directions.

Graduation Day will be Saturday, May 11, 1985 on the College campus. All graduates and their guests are welcome. The number of guests each graduate may bring could be limited by the space available. Please check with your coordinator.

This is a day of celebration for family and friends, as well as a social event, so please dress as you would for any special occasion.

Graduation will take place in two segments. First, graduates will take part in certificate/diploma granting ceremonies held by their own departments.
