CAPILANO College is the winner of the gold award for best institutional annual report (colleges) for 1996-97.

The award was presented by the Canadian Council for the Advancement of Education (CCAЕ).

The Prix D'Excellence is the prestigious annual awards program of the CCAЕ, which recognizes outstanding achievement in alumni affairs, public affairs, development, student recruitment and overall institutional advancement across Canada.

Produced on a cost-effective budget, the production received comments from the judges that included: "quality piece that avoids being overly glitzy," "clearly supports the mission statement," and "sophisticated design with top-notch photos."
