Grant benefits students, college

Capilano College was granted \$25,000 by the Department of Education for the hiring of students during the summer. The grant was part of the \$1 million for summer employment of students throughout the province.

Capilano College used the money to hire the students to help with summer projects at the College. Most of these tasks related to the College's move to its new Lynnmour campus, and some of the help was utilized on landscaping and beautification work on the grounds.
