## IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR CAPILANO COLLEGE STUDENTS

The Management and Faculty of the College have acted quickly in a concerted effort to work out arrangements so that students will be able to make up for recent missed classes. Fortunately, it has been possible to arrange for the completion of the Fall term without extending it into the new year. The Spring term will commence on time.

The arrangements, as announced at the College this last week, are:

- 1. The exam period has been **adjusted to** December 15-19 in order to extend class days.
- 2. The drop date for all courses and the date for changing from credit to audit status will be extended to Friday, December 12, 1986.
- 3. Hours of various instructional support services will be extended, where feasible, for the remainder of the term. The services involved are the Library (additional hours of 1-5 p.m. on Saturdays), Writing Centre, Media Resources Lab, Music Labs, and Computer Labs.
- 4. Individual faculty, after consultation with students, are making appropriate adjustments to class time for the purpose of covering course material. Any students who are not aware of these adjustments for any of their courses are urged to contact their course instructor for details.
