CAPILANO College Blues women's team coach Doug Abercrombie's record speaks for itself: 49-5-4 in eight years at the helm of the local team.

He's led the Blues to four straight B.C. Colleges Athletics Association titles — 1995 through '98 — and is on the verge of another three-peat this year. Add to that five CCAA national championships (1995-'96, 1998 and 2000-'01) and a silver CCAA medal in 1997.

And as if that wasn't enough: a North Shore Sport Award for coach of the year (2000), a gold medal as coach of the 1993 Western Canada Games team, a gold medal this summer as coach of the Surrey United women's Pacific Coast League team and six consecutive provincial championships for the U-11 to U-16 girls teams he's coached.

However, the best part about Abercrombie isn't his record—it's the fact that he maintains it's no big deal. He's got an admirable sort of "aw-shucksness" about the whole thing. He
