# **REVIEW THE REQUIREMENTS**

### **GENERAL ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS**

Admission requirements vary by program but, at a minimum, most CapU programs require successful completion of:

- B.C. secondary school (Grade 12) or equivalent (B.C. Adult Dogwood Graduation Diploma or General Education Diploma).
- A minimum grade point average (GPA) of 2.0 (60%) calculated on English Studies 12 or English 12 or English First Peoples 12 and two academic Grade 12 courses. See list of accepted Grade 12 courses: capilanou.ca/accepted-courses

If you do not meet high school graduation requirements or need to boost your high school grades before applying to a program, CapU can help. See capilanou.ca/upgrading



# **ENJOY AFFORDABLE TUITION**
