

PERFORMERS

MUHAL RICHARD ABRAMS — the "Elder Statesman" of Chicago's jazz musicians... in the mid 60's he helped establish the Association for the Advancement of Creative Musicians (A.A.C.M.), the original Musician's Cooperative. Muhal currently resides in NYC and his piano artistry and compositions are featured on numerous albums for Italy's "Black Saint" Records. He'll appear in a duet setting with bassist, DAVE HOLLAND.

PETER APPLEYARD - Last year's concert was such a distinguished affair - hot and breezy swing music. Peter Appleyard and the Alumni are back with another memorable salute to Benny Goodman. This is a rare opportunity to hear eight all-star musicians from various Goodman bands honoring the King of Swing with concert performances of classic Goodman favorites, and relating personal anecdotes of their experiences while in Goodman's employ. This heartfelt tribute is led by dynamic vibraphonist Peter Appleyard who has performed with Count Basie, Ella Fitzgerald, Frank Sinatra. Stan Kenton as well as Benny Goodman Peanuts Hucko (clarinet), Billy Butterfield (trumpet), George Masso (trombone), Butch Miles (drums), Russ Kasov (piano), Slam Stewart (bass). JON BALLANTYNE — superb young pianist from Saskatoon who studied at North Texas State University. At the Montreal Jazz Festival '86, his trio was voted the best new Canadian jazz ensemble. He has recently released his first album as a leader - MICHAEL BRECKER (MCA - Impulse) - and will appear in Vancouver with an all-star band: MIKE STERN (guitar), KENNY KIRKLAND (piano), JEFF ANDREWS (bass), ADAM NUSSBAUM (drums). BILL BRUFORD'S EARTHWORKS - Bill Bruford (percussion and synthesizer) used to be a guiding light in the British "Art-Rock" movement, touring internationally with "Yes" and "King Crimson". 




