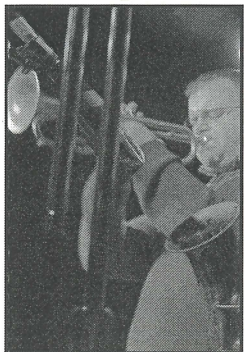

LEGENDARY SAXOPHONIST FRANK WESS

Born January 4th, 1922 in Kansas City, Missouri Frank Wess began music training in Oklahoma in 1932. He has toured with Billy Eckstine's Orchestra (1946-47) and was a member of The Count Basie Orchestra from 1953-1964 at which time he left to pursue a career as a freelance musician in New York. Since then he has recorded and performed with a who's who of jazz. Don't miss this rare opportunity to hear this legend up close. Appearing with Mr. Wess will be **Russ Botten on bass, Ross Taggart on piano and Craig Scott on drums.**

The Uptown Quintet is a group rich in the hard bop tradition with influences such as Horace Silver, Jackie McLean and Art Blakey's Jazz Messengers. "Live In New York" the bands debut CD was recorded at Smoke in Upper Manhattan just over a year ago and has been released on Cellar Live. Trumpet sensation Ryan Kisor is a member of Wynton Marsalis' Lincoln Center Jazz Orch. and is a sought after sideman. Ian Hendrickson-Smith has released two acclaimed CD's on Sharp Nine Records and is currently a member of Sharon Jones' Dap Kings. Spike Wilner has worked the likes of Tony Bennett and Wynton Marsalis and recorded 2 fabulous CD's. Rounding out the quintet are two of Vancouver's finest musicians; Jodi Proznick on bass and Jesse Cahill on drums.



September 23 / 24 Sharon Minemoto Quintet

Pianist / Composer Sharon Minemoto has been leading here quintet for the the last 4 years. The group recorded their first CD live at The Cellar back in 2002. 'Side A' has received critical acclaim across the country. The quintets brand of hard bop is sure to delight with wonderfully creative compositions by Minemoto as well as hip arrangements of some old standards. Its always a fun, high energy atmosphere at The Cellar when Sharon brings her band in. Appearing with Minemoto will be **Darren Radtke on bass, Ross Taggart on tenor sax, Brad Turner on trumpet and Bernie Arai on drums.**
