

An exhibition of prints by a group of British Columbia artists is currently being assembled in Vancouver. The works are going to be made available by mail as a touring exhibition around the Pacific Rim countries. We are trying to get responses from major museums, galleries and universities in the Pacific area in order to line up a series of showings starting in 1975. Concurrently with the exhibition, where possible, a music/multi-media concert will be arranged as part of a cultural package from Western Canada to its Pacific neighbours.

Included in the exhibition will be approximately 36 works in a variety of printing media and with an average size of 20"x28". The artists include: Edwin Varney, Gary Lee Nova, Chris Dahl, Gregg Simpson, Eric Metcalfe, Jack Wise, Vincent Tarasoff, Henry Rappaport, Michael Morris, Randy Gledhill, Michael DeCoursey, William Litchfield, and Jim Felter. All works are on paper and can be easily shipped in mailing tubes from showing to showing. In addition we have available at a small cost a travelling 35mm slide exhibition which covers various aspects of the art scene here.

We feel that an exhibition and cultural package of this nature can be instrumental in establishing valuable contact between all the Pacific Rim countries.
